 - Next 30 days
 - 1 mentor meeting, 3 den meetings, 1 pack meeting
- First 30 days Mentor co-leads meetings, provides structure, establishes routine with Den Leader
- Next 30 days Mentor observes, provides feedback, lets the den leader lead, steps in if necessary
