Bear, Webelos, AOL – Key Themes

BEAR

- Understand the three ecological compartments: Water, Soil and Air
- Focus on pollution and conservation

WEBELOS

- Understand the components of a habitat: Food, water, shelter and space
- Species conservation: threatened or endangered species, characteristics, causes, status

AOL

- Food: where is it grown, why local is often better, concepts of food deserts and oases
- Minimization of food waste
